

In the first parashah of Genesis, the world deteriorated over the course of 10 generations, from the pristine perfection of its beginning to corruption in the days of Noah. Instead, God continues with the same creatures, human beings, blessed with free will and cursed with the tendency to misuse that free will, who have brought matters to this point.
