Parashat Ki Tissa

At the heart of this *parashah* stands the incident of the Golden Calf, the classic example of Israel's angering God by worshipping an idol (or, more likely, worshipping God in the form of a physical being, which is forbidden by the 2nd commandment). God is prepared to renounce the covenant with Israel, and Moses has to prevail on God not to do so. The incident of the Golden Calf is preceded by several brief matters involving a census of the people, further details about building the tabernacle, and an additional injunction to keep *Shabbat*. Following the destruction of the Calf, God's reconciliation with the people is symbolized by the carving of a second set of tablets, because Moses had broken the original set.
