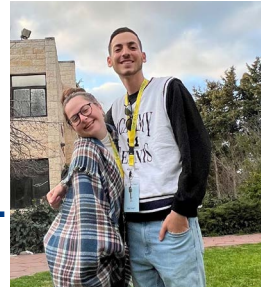
Pre-Rosh Hashanah Party

COVID-19 UPDATE

Following the guidance of our Medical Advisory Committee and current Public Health guidelines, Adath Israel Congregation no longer requires proof of Covid-19 vaccination to enter our building. Thankfully, given the high rate of vaccination in our city, requiring proof of vaccination no longer provides the level of safety it once did.

Receiving a Covid-19 vaccine with appropriate boosters remains the best way to protect yourself from serious Covid-19 related illness. Jewish ethics requires that every person who can be vaccinated be vaccinated.

Masks continue to be required during prayer services. We recognize that for some wearing masks serve as an impediment to focused *tfillah* and the ability to form community. We also appreciate that others are only comfortable in spaces where everyone is masked; this will be especially so during the High Holidays when we anticipate hundreds of congregants in the Main Sanctuary. The requirement to wear masks during prayer services will be revisited by our Medical Advisory Committee at the conclusion of the holiday season.

We pray that 5783 will be a healthy year for everyone.
